Readers' Passport

- Readers' Passport is a program intended for children attending the 1st grade of elementary schools
- The program aims at building of habit of visiting the library and spending free time reading
- Local authorities in Zadar have been funding the free enrollment into Zadar Public Library for all first graders from elementary and high schools

Readers' Passport

- the first-grade students are handed readers passports at the moment of enrolling the library
- The students collect stamps in their passports for each book they read, and these stamps bring them rewards



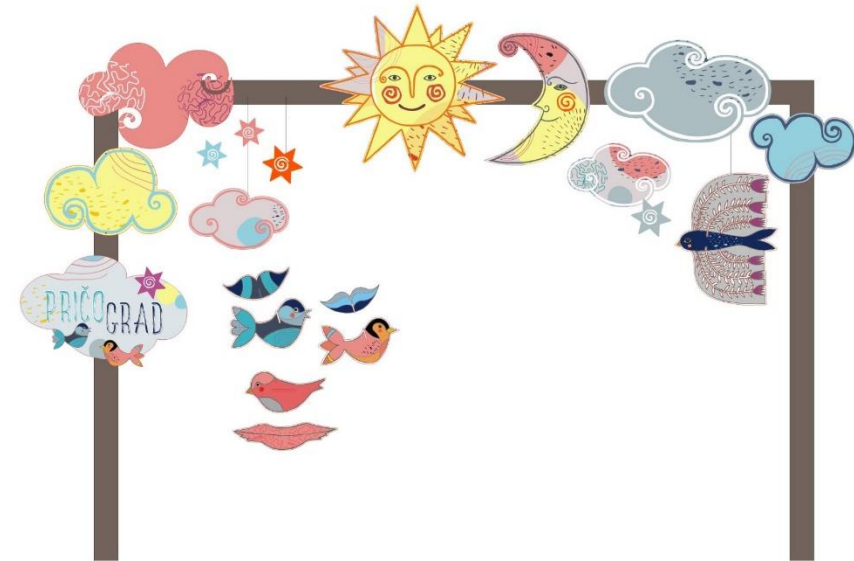


Storyville program

- meeting of young storytellers is an event where elementary school children perform rehearsed stories, fairy tales, plays and more
- The aim of the program is to promote reading, develop storytelling techniques and oral presentation, building of self-confidence and children creativity and practising of public performance
- The accent is put on importance of reading and richness of Croatian language. In collaboration with the Croatian National Theatre Zadar and the Bartul Kašić elementary school

Storyville program

- Elementary school children from 1st to 8th grade participated and program was hosted by Žana Bumber, an actress of Croatian National Theatre Zadar
- Program was envisaged and created by teachers Elza Nadarević and Meri Popović from the Bartul Kašić Elementary school
- The scenography was designed by Manuela Vladić Maštruko, an academic painter and children's writer, and illustrator







The brain needs exercise. Best by reading

- Program by the Zadar Public Library started in 2019.
- It encompasses an array of reading promotion activities as well as the activities aimed at acquiring the habit of reading
- Segment of the activities takes place in the opens spaces – in the libray yard and children playgrounds at the local sports centre



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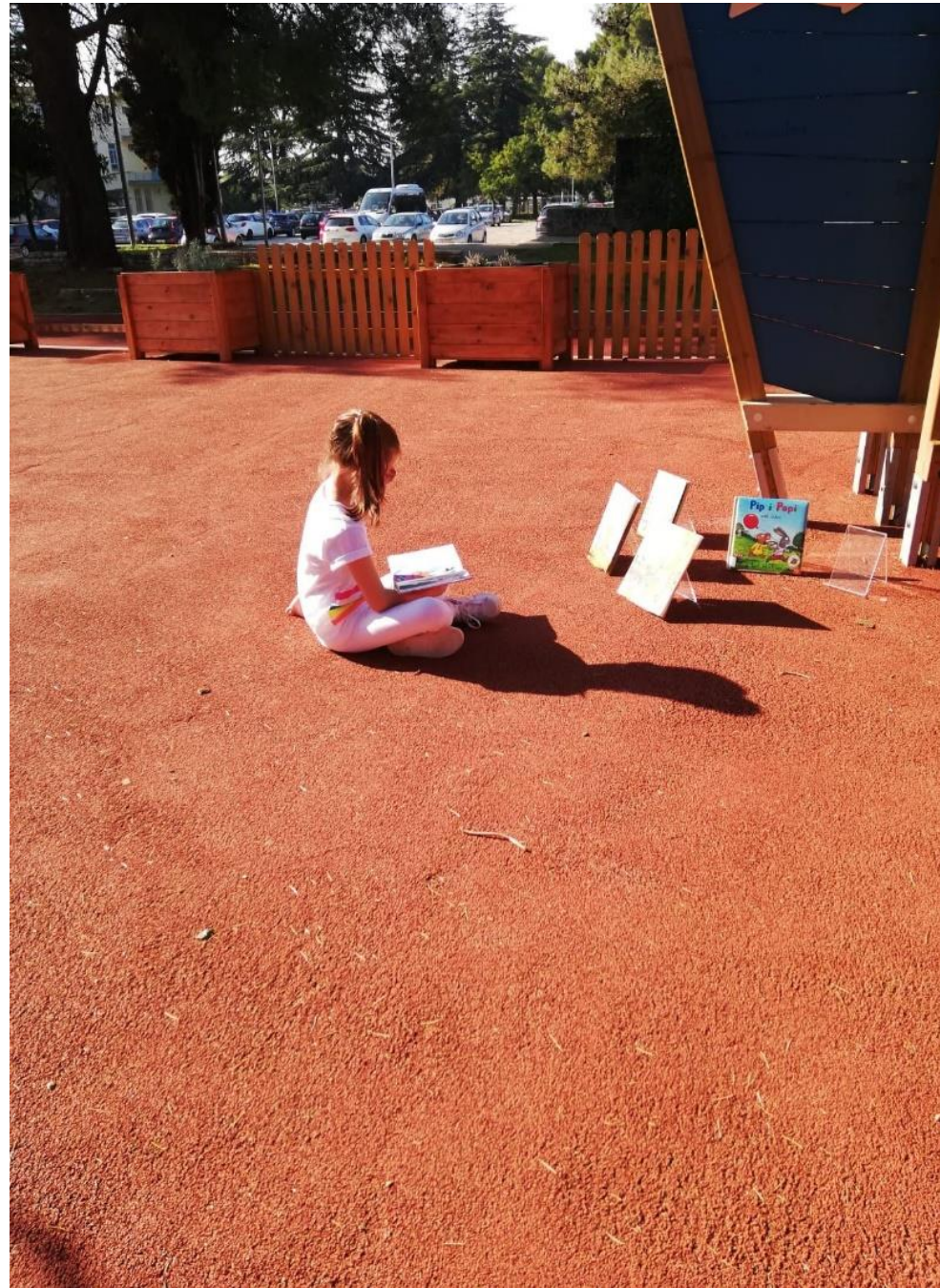
The brain needs exercise. Best by reading

Petit Scientists Project

- Project is carried out in cooperation with City of Zadar Centre of Excellence in Physics, Chemistry and Biology
- The project is intended for children in lower grades of elementary school and it gives children an opportunity to learn basic concepts of Physics, Chemistry and Biology

Petit Scientists Project

- The content of the program is intended for lower grades of elementary schools and it teaches pupils various concepts and knowledge in the field of chemistry through play and learning
- The workshops were carried out in the library branches by Andreja Kakša and Matija Kakša, chemistry teachers








Education for the e-Citizen system application


- The e-Citizen is a project by the Croatian government in the aim of modernizing, simplifying and expediting communication between the public administration and citizens as well as increasing transparency in the public sector regarding the provision of public services
- The aim of the program is to educate and raise awareness of the Library users and interested citizens about the use and application of this government service
